## **Background Information**

Young people who have received well developed, varied, up-to-date, impartial programmes of careers education and IAG in post 16 are more likely to make well informed, realistic decisions and progress in making smoother transitions.

This course is designed to help broaden knowledge of pathways to HE provision.

## **Aims**

To enable post-16 curriculum planners/deliverers of careers education and information, advice and guidance (CEIAG) to provide well informed, effective support to level 2 and 3 students in order for them to make clear choices about alternative pathways to HE.

## **Objectives**

1. To understand the context for IAG reform in careers education, looking at how new policy reforms offer opportunities for development, expansion and change in post 16 CEIAG programmes.
2. To gain an awareness of the full options available in FE, work and training ensuring post 16 careers programmes are kept up-to-date and developed in line with partnership requirements.
3. To enable participants to have an understanding of the influencing factors on students decision making about learning and work.
4. To update participants' knowledge of Labour Market Information (LMI) and the needs of employers in today's economic climate/changes in apprenticeships.
5. To explore resources that can be used in post-16 courses/tutorial programmes to support choices.
